### What is a MAIB-NOR?

A **Military Airworthiness Information Bulletin Norway** published by the *Military Airworthiness Authority Norway*, is an advisory document that alerts, educates and makes recommendations about airworthiness matters. Recommendations in these bulletins are not mandatory.

MAA-NOR will use MAIBs to inform the Regulated Community and other stakeholders about any matters concerning military airworthiness in Norway, it being news items, changes in the regulations, changes in the information pages published by MAA-NOR at [www.maanor.no](http://www.maanor.no), or more specific technical advice on how to ensure airworthiness.

A MAIB is issued to inform the aviation public, in a systematic way, of essential information not considered mandatory. The information contained in an AWB is for information only, and issued by MAA-NOR to disseminate information as quickly and as clearly as possible.

Military Airworthiness Information Bulletins will be numbered by year and sequence number, and will include an issue date. Each MAIB will be written in the same format as this bulletin. The headings utilised will reflect the information contained within the bulletin. Cancellation or notice that the MAIB has been superseded, will be indicated in the index list by deletion of all details except the bulletin number and inclusion of the statement "Cancelled" or "Superseded by". Within the text of the MAIB, the use of the words "must and shall" will be avoided.

Whilst these bulletins are for information only, they contain useful information concerned with the airworthiness of aircraft and aeronautical products. We recommend all aircraft operators and certificated organisations review bulletins for applicability and take any action they consider appropriate.
