Transition from EMAR to NOR MAR regulations for Norwegian military airworthiness

Purpose/objective

The objective of this MAIB is to provide information about the transition from EMAR requirements to NOR MAR regulations as regulatory vehicles concerning the airworthiness of Norwegian military aircraft.

Background for the change

Up to mid-2025, the MAA-NOR has issued the Airworthiness Regulation in the Norwegian Defence Sector as its' overarching regulation, and the individual EMAR documents have been issued as-is in the form of appendices to the Airworthiness Regulation.

The MAA-NOR is now changing the way EMAR documents are issued in Norway. In the future, the MAA-NOR will issue each EMAR document as a national regulation, with the designation NOR MAR (Norwegian military airworthiness regulation).

This will make the status of each document more clear as a national regulation issued in accordance with national procedures. It will also be easier to incorporate national deviations, although the intention is to keep such deviations to a minimum in the interest of standardisation, efficiency and interoperability.

This transition is underway, with NOR MAR 145 as the first regulation to be issued. This means that EMAR 145 is no longer issued as an appendix to the Airworthiness Regulation, but has instead been issued as Regulation for maintenance organisations (NOR MAR 145).

Going forward, the remaining EMAR documents will successively be issued as national regulations.

Status of AMC & GM documents

Until further, the MAA-NOR will not issue national versions of the complete AMC & GM documents. This means that for each NOR MAR regulation, the original EMAR AMC & GM as issued by EDA shall still be used.

However, the MAA-NOR is planning to issue national AMC & GMs to specific NOR MAR sections. These will be published along with the applicable NOR MAR regulation and with a defined scope and purpose.

NOTE that the numbering of sections and requirements in the NOR MAR regulations are retained from the original EMAR requirement sets. This means that paragraph 145.A.47 in EMAR still has the same number in NOR MAR. To find any corresponding AMC or GM, refer to AMC 145.A.47 in the EMAR AMC & GM document (or, where relevant GM).

Summary of changes from EMAR

Any substantial national changes or additional requirements will clearly be marked in coloured text. The replacement of the generic term "NMAA" with the term "MAA-NOR" is not marked with coloured text. Significant changes from the as-published EMAR requirements are not foreseen, as this would impact interoperability and add regulatory burden.

Implementation in MAA-NOR and organisations quality systems

MAA-NOR considers that the differences between EMAR and NOR MAR do not require an out-of-cycle update of the expositions. However, all organisations are expected to replace the EMAR references with NOR MAR at the next regular update of the certificates/documents/expositions.
